- C. Faucheux directed the board to Resolution #02-2022 a resolution authorizing the River Parishes Transit Authority Board Chair to complete the Federal Transit Administration's Certifications and Assurances for Fiscal Year 2022.
- C. Faucheux requested a motion for approval of Resolution #02-2022. Approval of the resolution was moved by H. Banquer and seconded by E. Broussard, III. Motion carried unanimously.
- C. Faucheux directed the board to Resolution #03-2022 a resolution authorizing the River Parishes Transit Authority General Manager to sign the Affidavit of Certifications and Assurances for Fiscal Year 2022.
- C. Faucheux requested a motion for approval of Resolution #03-2022. Approval of the resolution was moved by E. Broussard, III and seconded by H. Banquer. Motion carried unanimously.
- S. Van Sickle directed the board to the FY22 Section 5307 partial apportionment information including the proposed line items.
- C. Faucheux requested a motion for approval of the FY22 Section 5307 partial apportionment line items. Approval of the line items was moved by E. Broussard, III and seconded by K. Bourgeois. Motion carried unanimously.

The next meeting was proposed for March 10, 2022.

C. Faucheux requested a motion to adjourn. Approval to adjourn was moved by H. Banquer and seconded by E. Broussard. Motion carried unanimously.

Having no more business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 3:35pm.
